

Youtube Popup Video Widget

User Guide

The Youtube Popup Video Widget is a powerful tool that allows you to embed a Youtube video in your Magento 2 store and display it in a popup when a button is clicked. The widget comes with multiple options for customization such as defining the video's width, height, start time, autoplay, and the button's text and styling.

How to Configure the Widget

1. Log in to your Magento 2 Admin Panel.
2. Navigate to **Content > Widgets**.
3. Click on the **Add Widget** button.
4. In the **Type** dropdown, select **Youtube Popup Video Widget** and choose your current theme in the **Design Theme** dropdown, then click on **Continue**.
5. In the **Storefront Properties** section, give your widget a title and assign it to the necessary store views. You can also set the sort order if multiple widgets are set in the same container.
6. In the **Layout Updates** section, you can set where to display the widget.
7. In the **Widget Options** section, you will find the configuration options for the widget:
 - **Youtube Video Url:** Insert the full URL of the Youtube video you want to display.
 - **Width:** Set the width of the video (e.g., 500px, 100%, etc.). Leave it blank to use 100% width.
 - **Height:** Set the height of the video (e.g., 500px, 100%, etc.). Leave it blank to use 500px height.
 - **Video Start at:** Specify the start time of the video in seconds.
 - **Autoplay:** Select "Yes" if you want the video to play automatically when the popup is opened, or "No" if you want the user to manually play the video.
 - **Button Text:** Enter the text that you want to display on the button.
 - **Button Classes:** Enter the CSS classes that you want to apply to the button. Multiple classes should be separated by a space.
8. Click **save** to create the widget.

How to Enable/Disable the Widget

1. Navigate to **Stores > Configuration**.
2. In the left sidebar, under **ArmMage**, select **Youtube Widget**.
3. In the **General Configuration** section, select "Yes" or "No" in the **Enable Youtube Widget** dropdown to enable or disable the widget.
4. Click **Save Config**.

Please note: Even if the widget is disabled from the configuration, the widget instance will still exist and can be edited or deleted from **Content > Widgets**.

Note

Ensure that the URL you provide in the **Youtube Video url** option is a valid Youtube video URL. The video start time should be in seconds and it should be a positive integer.

Format URL example ex.(<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=adadadaaad>)

Remember to clear cache and re-index after making changes to your widget settings.
