SolanaPay Payment Module

Installation Guide

Introduction

This guide walks you through the process of installing the SolanaPay module on your Magento 2 store. SolanaPay allows you to accept cryptocurrency payments using the Solana block chain.

Prerequisites

- A running Magento 2 store (version 2.x).
- SSH (command line) access to the server where Magento is hosted.
- Basic knowledge of operating command line interface.

Installation Steps

Step 1: Upload the Module

- Download the SolanaPay.zip file to your local system.
- **Unzip** the file. You should have a folder named **SolanaPay**.
- **Upload** the **SolanaPay** folder to your Magento 2 installation's **app/code** directory. You can use FTP, SFTP, or similar file transfer method. The path should look like **app/code/ArmMage/SolanaPay**.

Step 2: Enable the Module

- Connect to your server via SSH.
- Navigate to your Magento 2 installation directory.
- Run the following commands:

php bin/magento module:enable ArmMage_SolanaPay

php bin/magento setup:upgrade

This will enable the SolanaPay module and run database migrations if necessary.

Step 3: Compile (for Production Mode)

If your Magento store is in Production mode, run the compile command:

php bin/magento setup:di:compile

This generates the necessary dependency injection configurations.

Step 4: Deploy Static Content (if necessary)

Deploy the static content to reflect the frontend changes:

php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy

Step 5: Clear Cache

Clear the Magento cache to ensure that the changes are applied:

php bin/magento cache:flush

Post-Installation Steps

After installing the module, you need to configure it from the Magento Admin Panel:

- Log in to the Magento Admin Panel.
- Navigate to Stores > Configuration > Sales > Payment Methods.
- **Configure** the SolanaPay module settings as per your requirements.

Verifying the Installation

To verify that the module is installed:

- Go to Stores > Configuration > Advanced > Advanced.
- You should see ArmMage_SolanaPay in the list of enabled modules.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues during installation:

- Ensure that you have followed all the steps correctly.
- Check the Magento var/log directory for error logs.
- Recheck file permissions and ownership in the Magento app/code directory.
