

User Guide:

Installation:

Step 1: Download the module

Step 2: Unzip it to Magento 2 root folder of Magento.

How to use:

```
php bin/magento module:enable ArmMage_LoginLog
```

```
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

```
php bin/magento setup:di:compile
```

```
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
```

```
php bin/magento cache:flush
```

Once the installation is complete, log in to your Magento back-end and navigate to the module settings.

Configuration:

In the back-office customer section, you will see the following configuration options:

Track Website Visit: Enable or disable the tracking of website visits.

Email: Specify the email address to receive daily updates on customer connections.

Email Template: Select the email template for the daily updates.

Save your changes by clicking the "Save Config" button.

Customer Tracking:

The module will create a new entry in the customer connection logs for each user connection (login) if the 'Track Website Visit' option is enabled.

Customer IPs will be visible in the back-office customer page for easier tracking.
