Our Magento 2 Canonical URLs module is designed to be easy to use and configure, allowing you to quickly improve your webshop's SEO. Here are the steps to use the module:

Install the module as described in the Installation Guide below.

1. Once installed, go to Stores > Configuration > ArmMage > Canonical URLs to access the module settings.
2. Enable the module for CMS pages and/or the contact page by selecting the appropriate options.
3. Save your changes and clear your cache to ensure that the module is working properly.
4. That's it! The module will automatically add canonical URLs to your CMS pages and contact page, helping to improve your webshop's SEO.

Installation Guide

To install our Magento 2 Canonical URLs module, follow these steps:

1. Download the module ZIP file from our website.
2. Extract the contents of the ZIP file to your Magento 2 installation directory.
3. Connect to your server via SSH and navigate to your Magento 2 root directory.
4. Run the following command to install the module:

```
bin/magento module:enable ArmMage_CanonicalTag
```

```
bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

```
bin/magento mcache:flush
```
